PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. This order shall dispose off afore-captioned two petitions.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent No.1 informs this Court that the trial is in final stage. The same is fixed for defence evidence.
3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner though does not dispute the said fact however, submits that the petitioners be allowed to raise all pleas before the trial Court at the time

of final arguments. He submits that at the stage of charge, application filed by the petitioner seeking discharge on the ground that he had already resigned from the relevant period of time was dismissed.

4. In view of the above, this Court finds no reason to interfere in exercising jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. at this stage. As prayed for by learned counsel for the petitioners, petitioners shall be at liberty to raise all pleas before the trial Court. The same shall be considered in accordance with law without being prejudice by the orders passed earlier.

5. Accordingly, the present petitions are disposed off.
