1 Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking interim bail for one month to the petitioner in case FIR No.123 dated 26.07.2023 registered for offences punishable under Section 22(c) of NDPS Act at P.S. City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab.

2 Short reply by way of affidavit of Avtar Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib has been filed. The same is taken on record. The stand of the State as spelled out in the status report reads as under :-

“6. That in order to verify the medical record of the mother of the petitioner namely Usha Rani, the police went to Shri Om Sai Multi Speciality Hospital, Sri Ganganagar (Rajasthan) from where the said Usha Rani is getting medical treatment. It was stated by the Doctors of the said Hospital that the said Usha Rani was operated upon for stomach surgery on 30.01.2024 and she was discharged from the Hospital on 06.02.2024.

7. That at present, the said Usha Rani (mother of the petitioner) is living in the house of her brother Krishan Gopal son of Lekh Raj who is residing at Sri Ganganagar with his family members. During the enquiry, it has been found that Krishan Gopal and his wife are looking after and taking care of the ailing Usha Rani.”
