1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondent No.3 to act upon the representation dated 09.11.2023 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent Nos.4 and 5 are creating unwanted problems for the petitioner. They are trying to implicate him in one or another case. The petitioner has preferred representation before Commissioner of Police seeking redressal of his grievances but of no avail. He further submits that grievance of the petitioner, at this stage, would be redressed if respondent No. 3 is directed to act upon aforesaid representation.
3. Mr. Inderpreet Singh Kang, AAG, Punjab asserts that Competent Authority would look into representation of the petitioner and resolve the issue within 8 weeks from today.
4. Disposed of accordingly.
