Prayer in the present writ petition is for seeking quashing of letter dated 06.11.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by the respondent No.5 vide which the petitioner has been called upon to furnish the details of the information sought vide the above said communication.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner being a professional dairy owner had to sell his cows outside the State of Punjab for which permission is required. It is contended that certain information has been asked for by the respondents including the I.D. proof

of the purchaser of the cattles whereas the petitioner intends to sell the cattles in the cattle fairs outside the State of Punjab and that he does not have any details of the intending purchaser. The condition of prescribing furnishing of information of the purchaser as a pre-requisite for grant of permission amounts to denial of the permission in its entirety.

Learned State counsel, however, contends that in the event of petitioner submitting the requisite documents/information as required, requisite permission shall be granted thereafter in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the same.

In view of above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to submit the application for grant of export permit. In the event of petitioner furnishing the said information, the necessary decision as regards the issuance of export permit shall thereafter be taken up in a time bound manner and preferably within a period of 04 weeks of the submission of the application along with requisite documents/affidavit with respect to the pending information.
