The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the impugned order dated 06.03.2002 (Annexure P-7), vide which the claim of the petitioner for assigning her the seniority in the cadre of Senior Assistant in accordance with the provisions contained in the Punjab State Assistant Grade Examination Rules, 1984 has been rejected and further a writ of *mandamus* has been sought directing the respondents to assign seniority to the petitioner by restraining promotion of other Senior Assistants, junior to the petitioner.

At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to contact the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, the instant petition is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to seek revival of the same in case anything still survives.
