1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 02.08.1996 whereby the quasi judicial functions of Regional Transport Authority have been delegated to respondent No. 2. and for setting aside the order dated 21.04.1997 vide which the respondent No. 3 has been granted extension of the mini bus permit.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No. 3 has fairly submitted that the permit of the petitioner has got been renewed after the judgment of the Division Bench of this court in *M/s Vijayant Travels Vs. State of Punjab* reported as **CWP-15786-1999** dated 20.12.2012 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
