NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner-Society impugning the order dated 22.04.1998 (Annexure P-5) passed by the respondent No.1 whereby, respondent No.4-Balwinder Singh has been ordered to be reinstated in service.

2. The present writ petition was admitted on 20.08.1998 and operation of the impugned order was stayed. However, it was made clear that respondent No.4 is at liberty to challenge his termination order before an appropriate authority, if so advised, in accordance with law. It has been submitted that as a matter of fact that respondent No.4 had already challenged his termination before the Labour Court, Gurdaspur.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent No.4 submits that respondent No.4 has died and fairly admitted that he had taken various adjournments for getting instructions from the legal representative(s) of respondent No.4. He has also submitted that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get further instructions from the legal representative(s) of the respondent No.4.
4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is abated. Liberty is granted to the legal representative(s) of the respondent No.4 to revive the same in case any cause of action still survives.
