1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 06.12.2022 passed in CWP-28019-2022.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 06.12.2022 passed in CWP-28019-2022 has since been complied with and representation of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 19.03.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
