1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that though the petitioners were placed in the waiting list qua the Advertisement No.15 of 2019 in respect of the post of Multipurpose Health Workers (Female), but the petitioners have not been given appointment whereas, the candidates who were not even in the waiting list, have been given appointment to the post in question by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that keeping in view the fact that the candidates who were not even in the waiting list, have been given appointment, the respondents should consider the claim of the petitioners for appointment against the vacant post which were part of the advertisement.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of the grievance as raised in the present petition, the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 22.12.2023 (Annexure P-10) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the legal notice dated 22.12.2023 (Annexure P-10) has been received and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
