The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.156 dated 19.11.2022 registered under Sections 457, 380, 511, 394, 120-B IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Cantonment, District Bathinda.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 08.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
