1. The prayer in the present Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is to issue a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing/setting aside the order dated 10.10.2023 (Annexure P9) passed by respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel would contend that the petitioners being the mother and brother of the deceased employee are claiming financial benefits on account of death of Charanjit Singh, who was working as Veterinary Inspector be released in their favour, as his widow i.e. Nirlep Kaur has been granted the appointment on compassionate ground. In this regard, a legal notice dated 14.12.2023 (Annexure P-8), has been served upon the respondents, which has yet not evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, submits that the petitioners are sanguine of it being considered in a positive manner, in case, a direction is given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner by granting them an opportunity of hearing.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Paramjit Batta, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection to the limited

prayer made.

5. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the legal notice dated 14.12.2023, Annexure P-8 and decide the same within a period of 2 months and if found entitled, necessary benefit be granted forthwith. However, in the eventuality of the relief being denied, a speaking order be passed, after associating the petitioners.
