1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the transfer order dated 16.01.2024 (Annexure P-8) has been effected during the mid-term, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner as the petitioner will have to shift from Delhi where she is actually residing while working in Gurgaon to Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner has any difficulty qua the transfer, the petitioner should make a representation before the competent authority and in case any such representation is made by the petitioner, the same will be considered and appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
