The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, which is endangered at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 as the petitioners are living together and intend to marry against the wishes of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents and prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

On the other hand, learned State counsel informs the Court that the Investigating Agency had already recorded the statements of the petitioners as has been informed by ASI Hardam Singh, Police Station Doraha, Ludhiana.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
