1. The present petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondents to allow the free movement of the mineral, Jamuna Sand etc. extracted from the quarry of the petitioner with a further prayer that the respondent-authorities be directed not to impound/detain the minerals/vehicles belonging to him and other transporter.
2. Vide interim order dated 25.08.1998, while admitting the petition, the respondents were directed not to restrict the movement of the petitioner to take his mines, mineral etc. subject to payment of tax, if any.
3. A perusal of the paper book would show that lease in favour of the petitioner was only for a period of one year and therefore, we are of the considered opinion that the present petition, as such, has become infructuous in view of the limited right at that point of time.
