1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to release the arrears of higher pension payable to the petitioner under the Employees Pension Scheme, 1995, in accordance with law, along with interest @ 18% per annum.
2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail the departmental remedies, in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
