By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for his release on regular bail in case FIR No.402 dated 03.06.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 506, 307 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mehendergarh.

2. Despite opportunity provided to the respondent-State, status report has not been filed.

3. Petitioner, alongwith co-accusd is attributed to have caused injuries to complainant Manish. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially, petitioner had been allowed bail vide order dated 07.07.2023 for offences under Sections 323, 324, 506/34 IPC after observing that knife injury was not attributed to the petitioner.

4. However, later on, Section 307 IPC was invoked and the bail to the petitioner has been declined vide order dated 25.01.2024 by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Mahendergarh, by observing that knife injury is attributed to the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends further that while on bail, petitioner never misused the concession of bail; that he is already in custody for the last more than 05 months, so he be allowed bail.

6. Learned State counsel could not refute the aforesaid contentions.

7. Having regard to all the aforesaid facts and circumstances as pointed out by the counsel for the petitioner, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
