The present writ petition has been filed for seeking
issuance of directions to the respondents to release the amount of
Rs. 2,07,586/- illegally and unlawfully deducted from the running bills
dated 17.06.2023 alongwith interest @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
contends that at this stage he would confine his prayer only to the
extent of directing the respondents to treat the representation dated
25.06.2023 as a representation to the Grievance Redressal Committee
pertaining to the illegal and arbitrary recovery of money against the

alleged shortage of goods from the bills issued to the petitioner, in a

time bound manner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents has no objection to the same.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting on the merits of the present case, directing the respondent-Grievance Redressal Committee to treat the Annexure P-8 as a representation in terms of Clause XX of MTF as a petition and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon within a period of four months of receipt of certified copy of this order and after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties. The parties shall, however, be at liberty to place on record any additional documents/objections as may be available to them.
