PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition is for quashing of order dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure P-4) whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against the petitioner in SC No.651 of 2018 in FIR No.130 dated 26.03.2018 registered under Section 379-B/34 of IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

2. The petitioner was admitted to regular bail vide order dated 13.06.2019. Owing to his absence on 27.09.2023 and thereafter on 18.11.2023, he was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants.

3. While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed:-

“Prayer is for quashing of order dated 18.11.2023 (Annexure have P-4) whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against petitioner in SC No.651 of 2018 in FIR No.130 dated 26.03.2018 registered under Section 379-B/34 IPC at P.S.Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, AAG, Punjab. appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the next date of hearing i.e. 20.02.2024.

Adjourned to 06.03.2024.

Impugned order dated 18.11.2023 (Anneuxre P-4) shall be kept in abeyance subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on or before 20.02.2024.”

4. Today, counsel for the petitioner has produced order dated 16.02.2024 passed by the Judge, Special Court, Amritsar to show that the petitioner appeared before the trial Court in terms of the directions issued vide order dated 07.02.2024 (supra).
5. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the trial Court regularly.
6. In view thereof, order dated 07.02.2024 is made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall furnish fresh bail bonds.
7. Petition stands disposed off.
