By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a case arising out of FIR No.67 dated 28.04.2020, under Sections 435, 427, 335, 188 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was never served during investigation; that he was declared proclaimed persons in an illegal manner in violation of Section 82 Cr.P.C., vide order dated 04.11.2023. Learned counsel contends further that petitioner filed a separate petition bearing No.CRM-M-10809-2024 for challenging the order dated 04.11.2023, whereby he was declared proclaimed person and that this Court vide order passed today itself, has quashed the said order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Sahil R. Bakshi, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the next date of hearing before the Trial Court is 18.03.2024.

6. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 18.03.2024, the date already fixed thereat. On his surrender, petitioner shall be admitted to bail by the Trial Court.
