N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to official respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been running from pillar to post but their grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioners have approached the Commissioner of Police, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar-respondent No.2 by way of e-mail/representation (Annexure P-3), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance

with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar-respondent No.2 to depute a senior officer to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today.
