MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition under Article 226 of Constitution has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of P-4, P-5 & P-7 and further issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No. 1 to promote the petitioner to the post of Restorer.

(2) Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 has produced the office order dated 23.11.2001, which is taken on record and marked as 'X'. Perusal of the above office order reveals that petitioner was promoted to the post of Restorer on 23.11.2001 in the time scale of Rs.3120-5160/-. Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 further apprised that petitioner has already retired after attaining the age of superannuation on 30.11.2023.

(3) In view of the above, learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that nothing survives in the present writ petition and as such, the same be disposed off.

Ordered accordingly.



(5) Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this petition, if so desired, and the same shall be considered as per law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
