This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of the order dated 18.08.2023 passed in CWP-14592-2023.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Mr. Ombir Singh, Superintendent Engineer, MC Faridabad, has submitted that necessary payment qua the bails which were submitted by the petitioner and were verified by the respondent have already been made. The payment of only one bill has not been made because in that bill, the work could not be verified.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, it would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
