SANJIV BERRY, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of writ, order or direction for the release of minor child alleged to have been in the wrongful detention of respondents No.4 to 6.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has limited his prayer in the present petition only to the extent of issuing appropriate directions to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 29.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the representation (Annexure P-1) shall be disposed of by respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

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5. Considering the respective submissions and the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to consider and dispose of representation dated 29.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
