NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 10.05.2000 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.1 and order dated 03.08.1999 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2, whereby recovery of Rs.81765.28 has been ordered from the petitioner.

2. On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that she has no instructions from the petitioner, therefore, notice may be issued to the petitioner.

3. As per office report, the petitioner has been served through his wife. However, there is no appearance on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present petition.



4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
