1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to grant pay scale as admissible to the post of Carpenter i.e. Group C.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Court vide judgment dated 12.01.2018 passed in CWP No.3574 of 2015 has extended benefit of higher pay scale to similarly situated Carpenters working with Punjab Police. The respondents in compliance of order dated 03.05.2013 passed by this Court in CWP No.9487 of 2013 has passed order dated 03.08.2013 (Annexure P-12) whereby higher pay grade has been granted to a similarly situated Carpenter namely Sukhdev Singh.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondednts-State and waives service.

5. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.

6. Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by judgment dated 12.01.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.3574 of 2018 as well as order dated 03.08.2013 passed by SSP, Faridkot in the case of Sukhdev Singh.

7. In the wake of statements of both side, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to adjudicate legal notice dated 12.10.2023 (Annexure P-16) in the light of judgments passed by this Court as well as orders passed by respondents in the case of similarly situated employees. The needful shall be done within 3 months from today.
