1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 06.01.2022 passed in CWP-35700-2019.
2. Counsel for the respondent has submitted that regarding the absence period of the petitioner, a specific order has been passed by the competent authority, denying the arrears on the ground of 'No Work No Pay'. However, all other benefits have already been given to the petitioner. Copy of speaking order dated 21.05.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
5. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
