The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.207 dated 26.12.2023, under Sections 302 and 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Satnali, District Mohindergarh.

This Court vide order dated 22.03.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 22.03.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from investigating officer, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 22.03.2024 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
