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AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

The appeal stands settled at Rs.2,35,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of proposal form dated 13.11.2024 duly signed by both the parties. Though, the total enhanced amount comes to Rs.4,70,000/- the liability of the Insurance Company is to the extent of 50% i.e. Insurance Company is directed to deposit Rs.2,35,000/- to the appellant.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the 50% of the enhanced amount of Rs.2,35,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs and Thirty Five Thousand Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant No.1-Jaswinder Kaur with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.12.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Respondents No.1 and 2 were proceeded against ex parte before the learned Tribunal and no application/appeal to set aside the said order was made by them. They have chosen not to cause representation before this Court also despite service.

As regards the remaining amount, the appellants shall be at liberty to file an execution application to recover the same in accordance with the law.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
