Prayer in the instant application filed under Section 151 of CPC is for placing on record medical examination report of the petitioner issued by Medical Board on 07.03.2023 as Annexure P-12.

Allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

CWP No.2494 of 2023 (O&M)

Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned order dated 20.01.2023 endorsed on 24.01.2023 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana in violation of the Instructions dated 31.01.2006 (Annexure P-4) issued by the Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana as the petitioner being physically handicapped government employee, is entitled to serve till the age of 60 years. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the



respondents to allow the petitioner to continue in service till the age of 60 years in view of the Instructions dated 31.01.2006 (Annexure P-4) and further direction be issued that the petitioner be taken back in service having permanent disability of 71% as per Disability Certificate dated 24.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) along with continuity of service and other benefits.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has been allowed to retire at the age of 60 years vide order dated 05.06.2023 (Annexure R-1), therefore, the relief claimed in the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having become infructuous.
