The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227 of Constitution of India, to decide the Civil Suit No. 4055 dated 03.10.2023, titled “Surjit Kaur v/s Jagtar Singh Sangha”, copy whereof is Annexure P-1, in a time bound manner.

Heard.

As evident from the head note of the revision petition, the suit was filed on 03.10.2023. On query by the Court, it is submitted by learned counsel that the suit is at the service stage. Copy of order dated 10.05.2024 has also been placed on record by learned counsel today. Perusal of the same reveals that it is at the service stage. Previous notice sent was received back with the report of respondentb having left the address. However, from the contents of the said order, it is evident that respondent/defendant is detained in custody in Modern Jail, Kapurthala, in some FIR, detail whereof is given in the said order.

On further query, it is submitted that now the case is fixed for 02.07.2024 and the Court below, has ordered production warrant of the respondent/defendant.

Such being the fact situation, it cannot be said that there is any delay on the part of the Court for proceeding further with the case.

In the given circumstances, considering the initial stage of the case, no time bound direction can be given to the Court below, to decide the case.

Hence, the revision petition is hereby dismissed.
