The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the order No.46125-27 dated 10.09.2002 (Annexure P-13) of the Chief Engineer, Punjab Water Supply and Sewerage Board, Patiala, whereby the pension of the petitioner was calculated illegally as per the pay fixed as Junior Engineer.

2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and respondent No.5 on the last date of hearing i.e. 08.05.2024 and notices were ordered to be issued to the petitioner, respondent No.5 and their respective counsels, namely, Mr. H.S. Bakshi, Advocate and Mr. Satinder Khanna, Advocate for 19.07.2024.

As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that nobody opened the door, notice issued to respondent No.5 has been received back duly served and notice issued to Mr. H.S. Bakshi, Advocate has been received back with the report that he is no more and Mr. Satinder Khanna, Advocate has been informed through email.

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same in case, any cause still survives.
