The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.262 dated 15.10.2022 registered under Sections 21, 25-61-85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station STF/SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 09.02.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
