1. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Mr. Ashok Saini, Assistant, HR PWD (B&R), Chandigarh, informs this Court that in terms of order dated 05.05.2022 passed by the Writ Court, the services of the husband of the petitioner have been brought on regular cadre to the post of Beldar in Group-D w.e.f. 01.10.2023 and all the consequential financial benefits shall be released in her favour within a period of two weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at

liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
