1. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant writ petition.
2. Leave granted.
3. Consequently, the extant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, with a mandamus upon the decree holder-Gram Panchayat, petitioner before this Court, to forthwith institute the apposite execution petition before the Collector concerned.
4. In case the said execution petition is filed within a period of one week from today, thereupon the Executing Court shall ensure that within a period of three weeks thereafter, but in accordance with law, the said execution petition is decided and/or successful execution being made of the decree of eviction, as becomes passed in favour of the petitioner herein.
