1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to make payment of the salaries of the petitioners which has not been paid since June, 1999 along with interest @ 18% per annum.
2. Since no one was present on behalf of the petitioners on the last date of hearing i.e. 13.08.2024, therefore, notice was ordered to be issued to Sh. Bhajan Singh Sodhi, Advocate, counsel for the petitioners.
3. As per office report, learned counsel for the petitioners has been informed telephonically. However, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.
4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
