The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the second time bound pay scale of Rs.2100-3700 w.e.f. 28.11.1994 and revised pay scale w.e.f. 01.01.1996 and to refix the pay of the petitioner, after the grant of all annual grade increments w.e.f. 01.11.1979 till today and to pay the salary for the period w.e.f. 25.07.1980 to 13.05.1982, 13.06.1985 to 07.03.1986, 06.06.1995 to 08.08.1995, 06.11.1997 to 23.02.1998 and to pay the arrears, etc. payable on account of revision of pay scale from time to time and on account of grant of annual grade increments w.e.f. 01.11.1979 till today along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date it became due till its realization.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 15.07.2024, the following order was passed:-
