

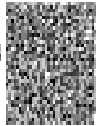

1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to restore the electricity connection of the shop of the petitioner.
2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last two dates. The position remains unchanged today as well.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 have pointed out that the present petition has been rendered infructuous since the petitioner has already been evicted from the demised premises.
4. In view of the above, it seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present writ petition.



5. The present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
