This petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *certiorari*, quashing the appointment of second respondent, who joined the College as Pharmacist on 10.03.1999.

2. Learned counsel for respondent nos. 1 & 3 contends that the petitioner was duly considered for the selection in question, and was not found suitable to be recommended for appointment. The second respondent, being at serial no.1 in the order of merit, was offered the appointment, and has rendered more than twenty-four years of service by now.
