1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 29.05.2023 passed in CWP-11747-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of short affidavit of Ajoy Kumar Sinha, Principal Secretary, Department of Finance, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 29.05.2023 passed in CWP-11747-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 22.03.2024 has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

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5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.

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7. Since the main petition has been dismissed being rendered infructuous, therefore, no further orders are required to be passed.
