The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks issuance of directions to respondents Nos. 1 & 2 for transferring the investigation of complaint No. 1955 dated 25.09.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420 / 406 / 506 / 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, to respondent No. 3 – Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, as also to register the FIR against the accused persons.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the complaint / representation dated 02.01.2024 (P-2) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

[3] The above prayer seems to be justified.

[4] Notice of motion.

[5] Mr. Shubham Kaushik, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection against

the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

[6] In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this petition is **disposed off** with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into the representation / complaint dated 02.01.2024 (P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of eight (08) weeks from today.
