1. Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents No. 3 to 5 to release property lying mortgaged with respondents No. 2 to 4. There is further prayer for initiating departmental inquiry and to register FIR against respondents No. 4 and 5 on account of forging the signatures of petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for respondents on 07.11.2023 had asserted that present writ petition is rendered infructuous as account of petitioner stood settled and closed, however, title documents of the secured asset cannot be released, as property in question is cross collateralized qua loan account of M/s B.D. Rice Mills. Son of proprietor of present petitioner is also one of the partners of M/s B.D. Rice Mills.

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3. Learned counsel for petitioner on 07.11.2023 had sought last opportunity to seek instructions and address arguments. None had appeared on behalf of parties on 19.02.2024 due to suspension of work by lawyers pursuant to resolution dated 17.02.2024 passed by the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association. Thereafter, learned counsel for petitioner had sought time thrice to address arguments.

4. Today, there is no representation on behalf of petitioner, who it appears is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

5. Accordingly, present writ petition is dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
