1. Instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC has been preferred seeking directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to take legal action against respondent No. 5 and further to investigate the complaint moved against respondent No. 5.
2. Heard.
3. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner moved a representation dated 22.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) before the Superintendent of Police, District Karnal, but no action has been taken thereon.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

- 6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 4.
- 7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Karnal, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 22.08.2023 (Annexure P-2), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
- 8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
