1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned show cause notice dated 17.07.1998 (Annexure P-8) and for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix the seniority of the petitioner with all consequential benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has instructions from the son of the petitioner that the petitioner has expired on 31.07.2022 and the legal representatives of the petitioner do not want to pursue the present petition. Accordingly, the present petition be dismissed as not pressed.
