The prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondent no.3 to decide the representation dated 20.07.2021 (Annexure P-21) sent by the petitioner to take necessary steps with the concerned authorities in USA to arrest respondent no.4 and deport him to India, as after revocation of his passport his stay in USA is illegal.

The Counsel appearing for the respondent no.1-UOI has filed reply dated 12.10.2023 and para 10 of the same reads as under:-

“ That the extradition request in respect of Mr. Rahul Chaturvedi after following the authentication procedure and approval of the competent authority was sent to the concerned US authorities, vide letter no.T-413/53/2023

dated 03.10.2023 through diplomatic channel-Embassy of India, Washington, USA for his consideration.”

In view of the fact that the extradition request in respect of the respondent no.4-Rahul Chaturvedi has been forwarded to the concerned US Authorities through proper channel, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

All pending applications also stand disposed of.
