1. The instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to form a special investigation team consisting senior officers of department in order to decide the representation dated 01.11.2021 given by the petitioner to the official respondents (Annexure P-6) and further directions be issued to respondent No.2 to conduct fair enquiry in the same and take appropriate action against the respondents No.4 to 6 for giving threats to the petitioner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of private respondents No.4 to 6, the petitioner had moved the representation dated 01.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) to the police authorities. He has also moved specific representation dated 01.03.2022 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, and again a reminder thereof (Annexure P-8) on 09.06.2022, but till date no action thereon has been

taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2 - The Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 01.03.2022 (Annexure P-7) along with reminder (Annexure P-8) (*supra*) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Daksh Prem Azad, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.
- 5. After hearing the respective submissions and also the averments made in the petition by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to consider and dispose of the representation dated dated 01.03.2022 (Annexure P-7) along with reminder (Annexure P-8) (*supra*) moved by the petitioner in accordance with law in an expeditious manner and the decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
- 6. Disposed of.
