NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the impugned order dated 28.04.1999 (Annexure P-9) and further a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents No.2 & 3 to consider the petitioner for granting him proforma promotion as Circle Superintendent from deemed date i.e. 02.03.1995, when the junior to the petitioner i.e. respondent No.4 was promoted.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3, on instructions, submits that during the pendency of the present writ petition, the petitioner and his wife have unfortunately died.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts he has not been able to get further instructions from the LRs of the petitioner.



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4. In this view of the matter, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the LRs of the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.

5. Pending application, if any, shall stands disposed of accordingly
