Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to decide the revision petition dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P-10) filed by the petitioner against the order dated 25.04.2023 (Annexure P-9) and also the order dated 20.09.2022 (Annexure P-8).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the revision petition dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P-10) filed by the petitioner is pending and he would limit his prayer that respondent No.2 be directed to decide the said revision petition in a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted that respondent No.2 would decide the said revision petition dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P-10), filed by the petitioner, in accordance with

law, within a period of two months from the date of certified copy of this order.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the revision petition dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P-10), filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of certified copy of this order.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.2 would consider and decide the matter independently, in accordance with law.
