Petitioner – Mukesh Kumar Mohta has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.0066 dated 03.03.2022 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 120-B, 409, 420 and 506 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station B.P.T.P., District Faridabad and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.
