Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing letter dated 15.07.1999, Annexure P-3, whereby respondent No.3 has declined to grant license to the petitioner for conducting business as a *kachha arhtia*.
2. Pursuant to order passed by this Court, Mr. Aman Bahri, Addl. A.G., Haryana, has sought instructions from respondent No.3. On the basis of verbal instructions received from Secretary, Market Committee, Hodal, he submits that the petitioner's license is being renewed from time to time and the prayer made in the petition has become infructuous.
