1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 05.07.2023 passed in CWP-12327-2023.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 05.07.2023 passed in CWP-12327-2023 has been complied with and necessary payment on account of Leave Travel Concession (LTC) has been made to the petitioner, as would decipher from the pay order (Annexure P-2).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
